**EU-FAS policy implementation on Navarra (Spain)**

The EU Farm Advisory Policy (EU-FAS) in Navarra is implemented through the Institute for Agrifood Technology and Infrastructures of Navarra (INTIA), a public body attached to the Department of Rural Development and Environment of the Government of Navarra, Spain.

INTIA is the only advisory organisation accredited by the Government of Navarra to perform the advisory service to farmers who carry out their activities in the region.

The target audience of INTIA's advice is every farmer and owner of a farm registered in the Registro de Tierras de Navarra, who can voluntarily access the advisory services. The advisory services are different in agriculture and livestock farming, but in both cases, there is a charter for each service with its specificities.

It is important to bear in mind that INTIA has been carrying out the function of impartial public advice for the past 40 years, being therefore a highly consolidated service well appreciated by farmers.

The main strength of the service is in the technical and economic assessment of the production processes of crops and livestock, based on own experimentation results and taking into account existing legislative frameworks, especially in relation to conditionality and the CAP.
